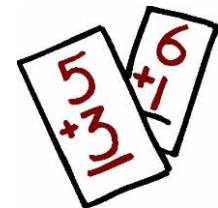
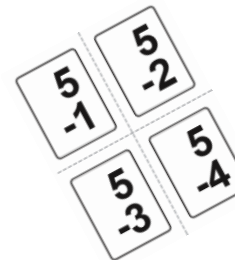
- 1 backpack

GRADE 3

- **NO MECHANICAL PENCILS**

- **PLEASE CHECK SUPPLIES OFTEN AND KEEP THEM AT THIS LEVEL. REPLACE LOST, BROKEN OR DRIED UP ITEMS.**

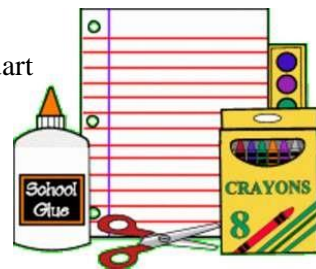
